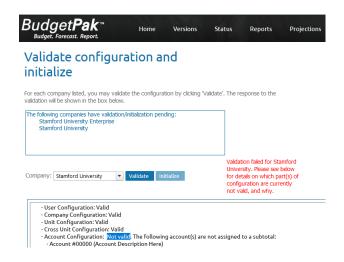
You asked...We delivered

The following new feature is now available:

• Hourly Compensation - Employees can now be designated as either salaried or hourly, or both. There is a new special section for hourly employees called "Hourly compensation". Hourly employees are budgeted by designating, for each pay period, the number of hours worked and the per hour rate. This is done separately by wage type. The wage types are configurable, but typical ones are regular wages, overtime wages, sick, holiday, and vacation.

Did you know? How do I find and fix errors that I receive during validation?

If the validation turns up errors, you will get a message with details about the validation error, and a summation notice that BudgetPak is NOT ready for initializing. You will have to make some adjustments or corrections to configuration before you can successfully initialize. To find what is preventing initialization, search for the terms 'Not Valid' or 'Error'. You can search using Control F. Read the error messages carefully! They are usually very good at telling you precisely what's wrong and what to do to fix it.



Validation may also turn up warnings. Warnings will not prevent you from initializing, however they can still be just as critical to correct. It is important to read and understand the warnings before initializing.
