You asked...we delivered

Our latest release of BudgetPak included the following enhancements:

- **Configurable P&L report** - rename the P&L reports and add additional formulas and subtotals to it, such as Net Tuition, EBITDA, or Gross Operating Margin.
- **New Account Guide** - walks you through all the steps for creating a new account.
- **Sign off all headcount sections in bulk** - on the Status page there is now an option to bulk sign off on all headcount sections, which is available for users with super admin or 'change all budget' permissions.
- **Reference Accounts** - assign a expiration year on an account so it no longer appears in budgets after that year.

Did you know?

Can I edit an account so it no longer appears in budget versions?

The latest release of BudgetPak introduced a new option that allows you to assign a fiscal year expiration to an account. This allows historical information to stay intact, while no longer showing the account in current and future year versions.

There are two areas where you can update an account to have a final fiscal year:

1. On the Accounts page of the Configuration menu, you can edit an account, and then enter a 'Final Fiscal Year'. This is best if you are only editing a few accounts.

Configure accounts

Configure both enterprise and company accounts here. When you configure accounts for the enterprise, the Source fields do not apply. Each company account must be mapped to an enterprise account. Multiple company accounts may be mapped to a single enterprise account.

2. On the Configuration Data page of the Configuration menu, you can export 'Company Account Changes' and update the column for 'Final Fiscal Year'. Then import the template back into the Configuration Data page. This is best for when you have to edit a lot of accounts at once.

DefaultSubtotalDescription	Optional.
FinalFiscalYear	Optional. Enter a fiscal year number if this account will no longer be used after that year.
