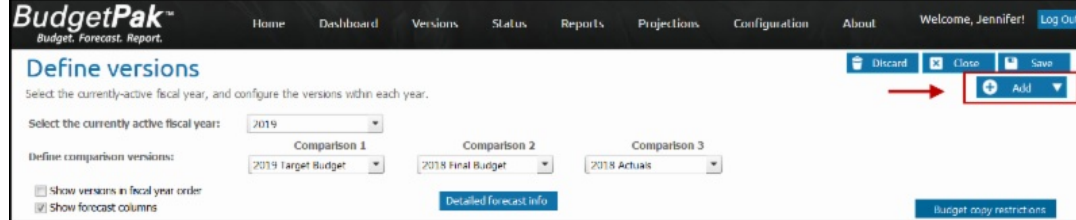
Our latest release of BudgetPak included these enhancements:

- **Start and erase multiple budgets/forecasts:**
Prior to this release, the Versions page had a function called "Start ALL budgets/forecasts". This function has been renamed "Start multiple budgets/forecasts," and an additional function to erase multiple budgets and forecasts has been added.
 - **Reporting/main menu:**
You can now go directly to the Advanced Reporting or Saved Reports pages from the main menu, without first going to the main Reports page.
 - **Projections:**When editing or viewing a projection, the two leftmost columns are now frozen so you don't lose context as you work with columns further to the right.
 - **New reporting features:**
 - For P&L reports, if you choose to include extended detail on the report, any notes associated with the overall budget are now displayed in a subreport.
 - For P&L reports, when reporting on a rollup unit, if you choose to include extended detail on the report, all account notes from the rollup unit's immediate children are displayed together in a subreport.
 - Exporting to Excel now labels each sheet tab with the unit code.

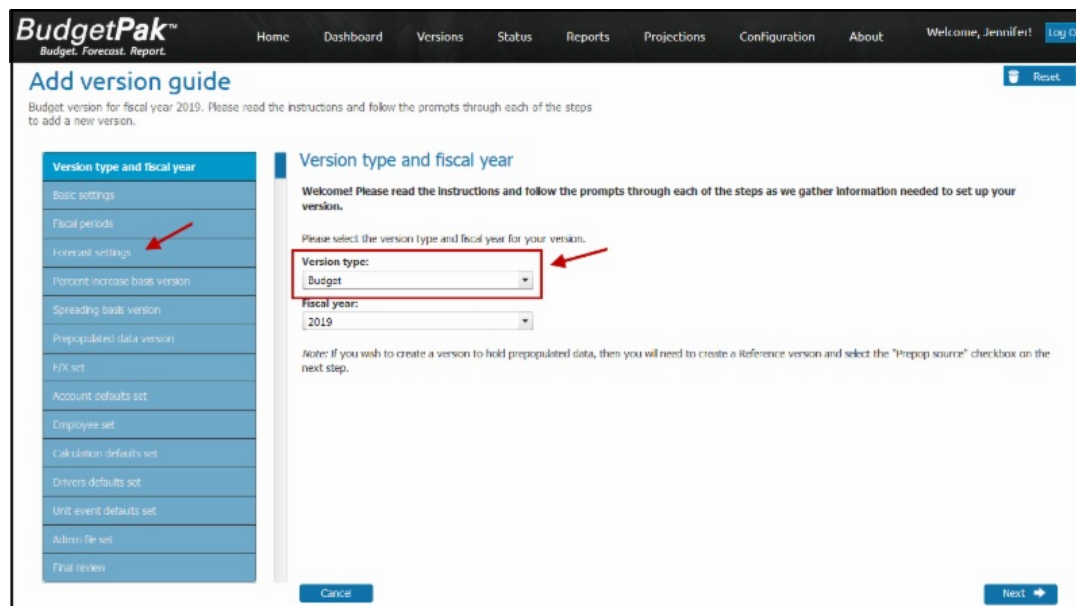
Did you know?

How do I utilize the new Add Version Guide?

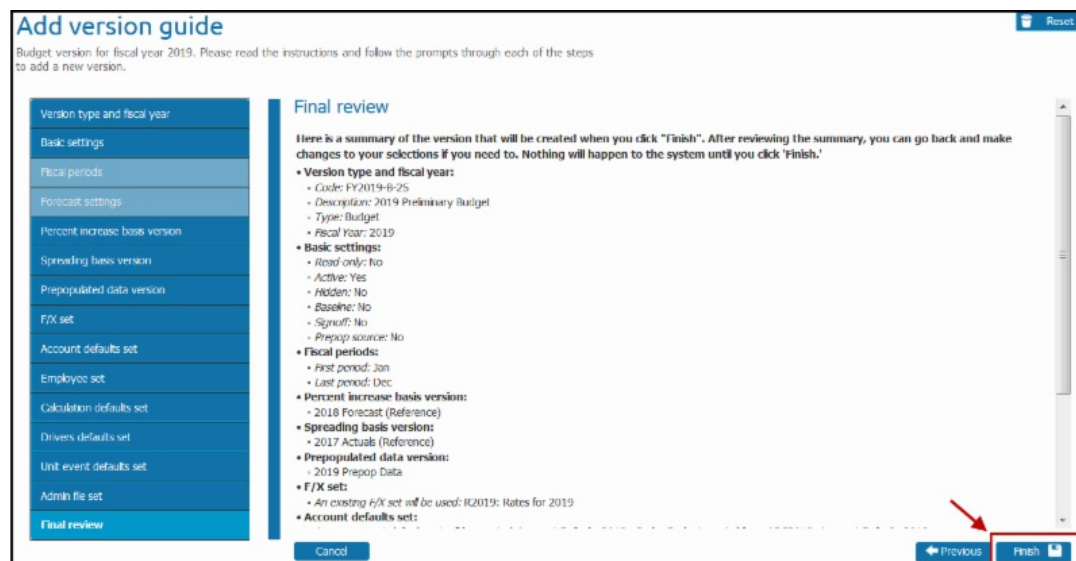
The Add Version Guide simplifies the system administrator's task of creating and setting up a new version in BudgetPak. To access the Add Version Guide go to **Define versions** on the configuration page. Click on the **Add** button.



The guide walks you through all of the steps required to set up your new version. The steps will vary depending on the requirements of the version type you select. In this example, version type Budget is selected. Therefore, BudgetPak will skip the Forecast settings step. However, if you selected Reference as your version type, the guide will skip the following steps: Forecast settings, Percent increase basis version, Account defaults set, Employee set, Driver defaults set, Unit event defaults set and Admin file set.



In the last step, Final review, you can review all of the selections you have made.



At this point, your selections have not been saved in BudgetPak. You can go back and make changes. Once you have completed your review click the **Finish** button.

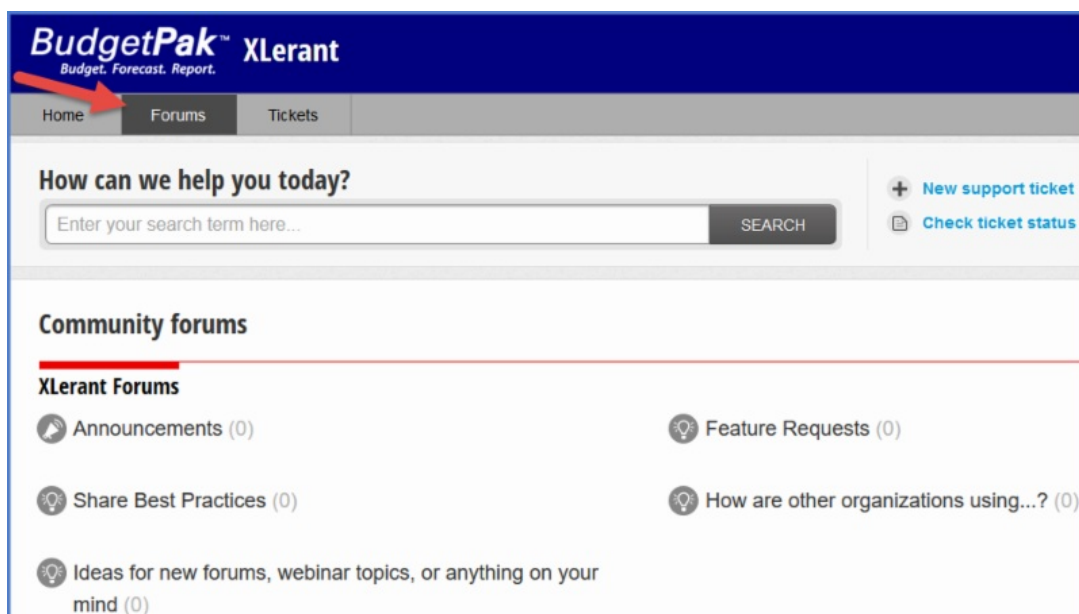
