Did you know you could have multiple budget versions for the same fiscal year?

There are different approaches you could take to your budget process, that include having more than one budget version for the fiscal year. Three popular approaches include:

1. Having multiple budget versions open at one time
2. Having multiple rounds of budgeting - where one version is open at a time
3. Scenario modeling - using different sets (or assumptions) for each version

Versions can be setup as 'hidden' on the Define Versions page, in order to restrict access to only users with permissions to see hidden versions.


