



# XLerant Case Study A Smarter and Faster Way to Budget for Clubs using BudgetPak

Managing a club's finances isn't just about balancing the books—it's about preparing for an unpredictable, seasonal business while keeping operations running smoothly. Many clubs have long relied on spreadsheets to manage their budgets, but as club finances grow more complex, Excel simply can't keep up.

This case study explores how several clubs across the U.S. made the switch to BudgetPak, moving away from frustrating, error-prone spreadsheets to a system that saves time, improves accuracy, and makes budgeting easier for everyone involved.

Clubs like Philadelphia Cricket Club, Cincinnati Country Club, Sawgrass Country Club, Eagle Creek Golf and Country Club, and Elevate Technology face a unique financial challenge: balancing a mix of full-time, part-time, and seasonal employees while managing fixed and variable expenses, and revenue streams from memberships, dining, events, and golf operations.

With so many moving parts, financial planning must be precise, flexible, and easy to update. However, for years, clubs relied on traditional spreadsheets that made budgeting more difficult than it needed to be.

## The Problem – Why Excel Wasn't Enough

For most clubs, budgeting with Excel was a tedious, manual process that left too much room for error. Finance teams spent hours creating and distributing spreadsheets, tracking down broken formulas, verifying numbers, and consolidating multiple spreadsheets for reporting. Even the smallest mistake—like a deleted formula—could throw off an entire budget.

In addition to being inefficient, spreadsheets made it difficult to get department heads engaged in the budgeting process. Many weren't comfortable using Excel, and without an easy way to collaborate, budgeting often became the sole responsibility of the finance team.

I spent the majority of my time during our 4-month budget process checking and rechecking and making sure the numbers are correct and rolling up properly. I couldn't do any analysis because I spent so much time on the spreadsheets.

Handling payroll was another challenge. It is very difficult or impossible to budget by individual employee using a spreadsheet. Clubs needed to account for fluctuating seasonal staff, multiple pay rates, different benefit structures, and taxes. Excel isn't designed to offer a simple way to manage these variables. Forecasting was equally difficult, as running multiple budget scenarios required manually adjusting figures in multiple files.

#### The Evaluation – Searching for a Better Approach

Recognizing the need for a better system, club finance teams began evaluating budgeting solutions.



I was looking for a system that I didn't have to worry about...with the service that we expect.

Generic financial software programs failed to meet the needs of a club. They either lacked flexibility, required extensive customization, or were too complex for non-financial managers to use effectively. BudgetPak stood out because it was designed with the club industry in mind. It

offered an intuitive interface, easy driver and calculation setup, built-in forecasting tools, and seamless payroll budgeting—all backed by a support team that understood the unique financial challenges clubs face.
